
QUADRAVERB GT QUICK SET UP



TO EDIT A PROGRAM

- Push the button associated with the Effect Group (Reverb, Delay, Pitch, EQ, Preamp) or function (MIDI, Config, Mix, Mod) you want to edit. The LED in the middle of the button will light.
- Press the PAGE UP and DOWN buttons to select a page containing a parameter to be edited. The harder you press the PAGE button, the faster the pages will scroll.
- A small line under a parameter indicates it can be edited. Use the VALUE buttons to change a parameter's value. The harder you press the VALUE button, the faster the values will scroll.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 until all the parameters you want to edit have been edited. Note: A decimal point to the right of the program number indicates that you are listening to an edited program. You must save an edited program before selecting another program, or your edits will be lost. Each parameter has a default value that works well in most applications. To return to this value, press both VALUE buttons simultaneously.

COMPARING EDITED AND NON-EDITED VERSIONS OF PROGRAMS

- 1. Press the PROG button.
 - Press the PAGE UP button. The display says
 * COMPARING * and you can hear the program you started with.
- To exit compare mode, hit any button except a VALUE button. IF YOU PRESS A VALUE BUT-TON, YOUR EDITED VERSION WILL BE LOST.

TO SAVE (STORE) EDITED PROGRAMS

- Press the STORE button. The LED in the middle of the button will light.
- To save to a different program number, press the appropriate VALUE button to select the desired program location. This edited program will overwrite the program stored in this location. Before saving, make sure the program to be overwritten is expendable.
- Press the STORE button a second time to save the program. The display will say PROGRAM STORED.

TO RECALL INDIVIDUAL FACTORY PRO-GRAMS

- Press STORE. The LED in the middle of the button will light.
- Press the PAGE UP button to select the Recall page.
- Press either VALUE button to select the program to be recalled (the first parameter).
- Press the PAGE UP button again to move the cursor under the second parameter.
- The factory program will be recalled into the program selected as the second parameter. Press either VALUE button to select this program number.
- Press STORE to complete the recalling operation.

TO RECALL ALL FACTORY PROGRAMS

- Press STORE. The LED in the middle of the button will light.
- Press the PAGE UP button three times.
- Press STORE and all the program locations will be occupied by factory programs. Any other data will be overwritten.

QUADRAVERB GT DEMONSTRATION PROGRAMS

This chart will give you a quick look at some of the concepts behind the QUADRAVERB GT Programs.

These simple and easy edit instructions are provided for 3 of the GT Programs to help you make some powerful alterations in the sound very quickly... without having to open the instruction manual.

BUT FIRST, YOU MUST SET LEVELS...

TO SET LEVELS:

Set the INPUT KNOB so that ALL THREE GREEN LEDS ARE LIGHT-ING with the RED LED LIGHTING OCCASIONALLY. If your guitar

does not sustain smoothly to silence, or seems to decay prematurely, the NOISE GATE will need to be adjusted:

TO ADJUST THE NOISE GATE:

- 1. Press PRE-AMP
- 2. Press the PAGE Up button 7 times to reach NOISE GATE.
- Press VALUE Up or Down while holding a guitar note or chord and adjust accordingly.
- The Gate might need readjustment depending on tree program you are playing.

- TO RECALL ALL FACTORY PROGRAMS: 1. Press STORE. 2. Press PAGE UP three times. 3. Press STORE.
- TO SCROLL TO THESE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAMS: 1. Press PROG. 2. Press VALUE Up or Down.

PROGRAM 00 GUITAR BY ALESIS

This program features heavy Distortion, Stereo Delay and Stereo Reverb. The aggressive punch needed for lead playing comes from a solid boost in midrange tone via the 3 band parametric EQ.

To very easily change the tone contour of this program, the Quadraverb GT has 6 Preset EQ curves:

- 1. Press the EQ button once.
- Press the VALUE Up button repeatedly to hear each of the 6 Preset EQ curves.
- TO RETURN TO THE FACTORY PRO-GRAMS, press PROG and scroll with the VALUE buttons.

PROGRAM 01 GTRBYAL+OD+RES

This program is a variation on Program 00 with the addition of Overdrive and Resonators. Notice the extra bite and harmonic resonance provided by these features.

To easily change the tonal character of this Program follow the steps outlined for program 00.

Be sure to try EQ Presets 5 and 6 which provide powerful alterations of the Resonator settings.

PROGRAM 07 PURE QUAD

PURE QUAD spotlights the digital signal processing section of QUADRAVERB GT. Stereo Reverb, Stereo Chorus and Stereo Delay are all active. The analog preamp section is used for tone shaping with Cabinet Simulator 1, Bass Boost and Bright Preamp Torre.

To alter the MIX settings of the reverb, chorus, and delay:

- 1. Press the MIX button once.
- Press the PAGE Up button repeatedly to scroll to Pitch Level (for Chorus), Delay Level or Reverb Level.
- Press VALUE Up or Down to alter the level of the chosen effect.
